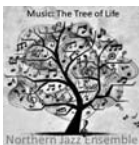
8:00pm - The Hustle Brothers

2:30pm - Brian Tremblay

After creating an interview program called "Rock N Roll Heaven" on new local internet radio station The Borderline, Brian Tremblay was inspired to pick up the guitar again. Brian Tremblay's music harkens back to the outlaw country singer/songwriters like Townes Van Zandt, Blaze Foley, Steve Earle and Guy Clark. Slipped in with that mix are his early influences of The Beatles and The Monkees. It was the songwriter's storytelling ability that he was drawn to.



3:30pm - Matthew James

Matthew James is a Sault Ste. Marie based songwriter. He has been honing his eclectic and familiar folk/pop sound for the last decade and a half. His collected work purposefully meanders through genre bending vibes as he grapples to come to terms with the comings and goings of a hard life hardly lived. His percussive acoustic sound and expressive live performances spring an outpouring of nostalgia that harkens back to the perfect campfire jam session with the people you love the most. This up-and-coming artist is emphatically not one to miss.



4:30pm - MD Dunn

Born in Sault Ste. Marie, I have lived here most of my life. I write songs because I have no choice, they happen, and I took up guitar as a way of remembering the songs. Being self-taught, I have no one to blame for my guitar playing. I try to make the sounds I hear in my head, for better or worse. Songs are like spirits, or perfect ideas, objects that live in another place. They come into the world through music and are cloaked in the writer's experiences. Maybe not all songs are like that, and maybe only parts of songs are that way. It's just a hunch. Most of my songs are written in the background, subconsciously built from all my experiences, memories, observations, things I hear people say. Usually, the songs reveal themselves over time. It feels like the song has been there all along, waiting to be uncovered.



5:30pm - Distich

Distich is a band local to Sault Ste. Marie consisting of siblings Jasper and Meadow (lead vocals and guitar), Jakob on drums, and Alder on bass. Distich writes and performs catchy pop-rock originals.



6:30pm - Hollow Heads

Hollow Heads are a young alternative indie rock band with their own flavour of crunchy licks, warm chords, and steady rhythm, topped with beautifully soulful vocals. 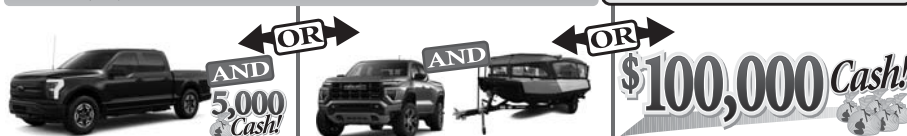

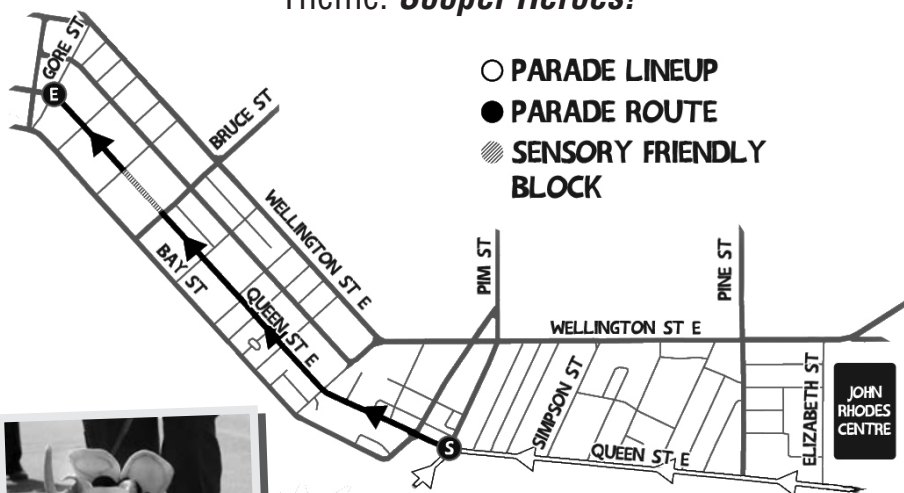

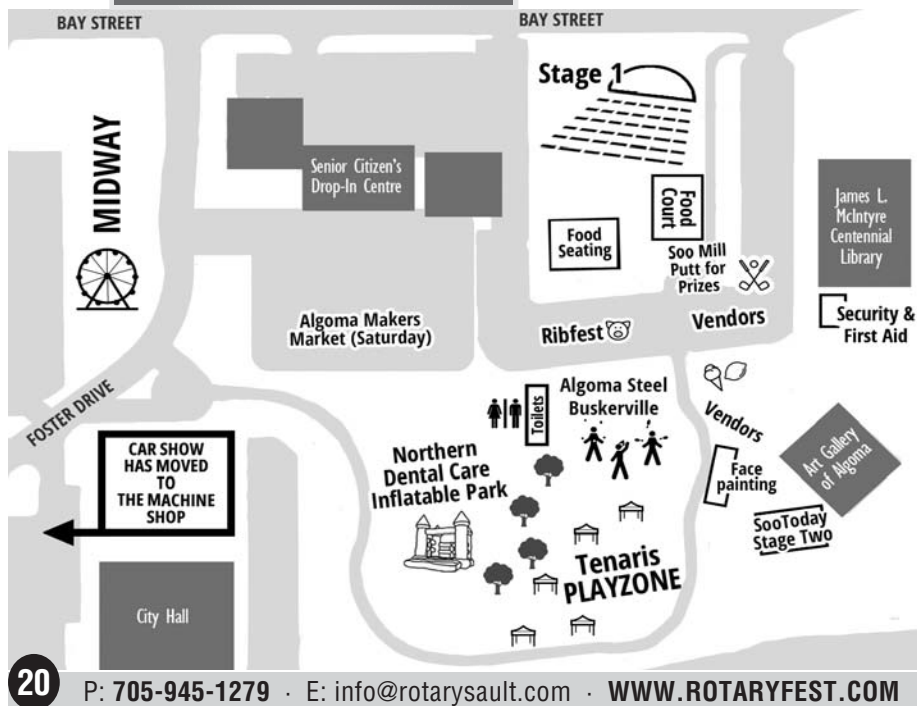
