The **Miracle Mile Colour Blast** is an exciting and energetic event in the community to have fun while raising money for Rotary Youth Charities! This run takes place right before the Rotary Community Day Parade, so thousands of people will be lined up along the parade route to cheer you on and see your community spirit!

The event will take place on **Saturday, July 18th, 2026**
The start time is set for **10:30am** at the Canadian Bushplane Heritage Centre and will finish at the GFL Memorial Gardens parking lot.

There will be two heats for the run:

The first heat will be for those wish to run and will start at **10:35am**. The second heat will be more family and walker friendly and will start at **10:40am**. We ask participants to hangout after the race for FREE refreshments, a group photo opportunity, and the final colour blast!

REGISTRATION:

Friday, July 17th from 10:00am to 4:30pm at the Canadian Bushplane Heritage Center

OR

Saturday, July 18th from 9:00am to 10:20am at the Canadian Bushplane Heritage Center

Cost to register is **\$20 for Individuals**. This includes:

- Miracle Mile Colour Blast sunglasses (made from recycled plastic)
- An individual colour pack for the final blast
- A Miracle Mile Colour Blast t-shirt (adult unisex sizing)

Cost to register is **\$50 per Family**. This includes:

- Miracle Mile Colour Blast sunglasses for up to 5 family members: 2 parents/guardians and 3 children under the age of 18 who are still living at home (children 2 and under are free).
- An individual colour package for the final blast for up to 5 family members
- Two Miracle Mile Colour Blast t-shirts
 - Extra shirts may be purchased, as available, for \$15/each

(These can be filled out on the day of the race at registration, but if you are under the age of 18 it is strongly advised you print this form and get your guardian's signature in advance, as you will not be allowed to participate without their consent)

A COLOURFUL F.A.Q.

What IS the colour made of?

The colour is a powder made of cornstarch and non-toxic dye. It is very safe.

Is this a competition?

No, this run is all about having fun and being part of the community. You are encouraged to run/wheel at whatever pace you like. It will not be timed.

I don't want the colour, can I still participate?

Yes! You can skip the colour stations.

Is there an age limit for younger people?

There are no limits for this event. If you can run/ walk/wheel this distance you are welcome to participate. However, if you are under the age of 18, a guardian must sign a waiver before the start of the race in order to participate.

Can I use my bike or rollerblades?

No. We only allow "wheels" that are part of mobility equipment or strollers.

IS there a dress code?

You are encouraged to be creative and wear as much white as possible. Just remember: the dye from the colour may be difficult to wash out of different materials.

How does registration work?

Pre-registration will take place on Friday, July 17th from 10:00am-4:30pm at the Canadian Bushplane Heritage Centre (skip the line) and on Saturday, July 18th from 9:00am-10:20am before the race.

Can I bring my pet along?

No pets, please.

Do the colour stations cause vision problems or breathing problems?

It is unlikely the colour stations will cause these sorts of problems. If you are still unsure, we will be providing you with a pair of sunglasses that will help protect your eyes. You can also wear a dust mask or bandana to protect your nose and mouth. If you have any condition that may affect how you react to this sort of activity, we encourage you to use your best judgement.

Will there be cleaning stations at the finish line?

No, so you may want to keep a change of clothing on hand and lay down a towel for the car ride home.

Can I just volunteer?

Absolutely! We have lots of volunteer opportunities, and would love your help. The Miracle Mile Colour Blast is just one of the many events we are putting on this year at ROTARYFEST. ROTARYFEST could not happen without the 200+ volunteers that help out.

MIRACLE MILE COLOUR BLAST WAIVER

BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT YOU WILL WAIVE OR GIVE UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR CLAIM COMPENSATION FOLLOWING AN ACCIDENT

I hereby desire to participate in the "ROTARYFEST Miracle Mile Colour Blast" on July 18, 2026 on City Property as organized by Rotary Club of Sault Ste. Marie, hereinafter referred to as the "Activity".

I UNDERSTAND AND ACKNOWLEDGE that there are many inherent risks, dangers and hazards associated with the Activity, including bodily injury, death and loss or damage to the property. I AM AWARE OF THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ACTIVITY AND I FREELY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS AND THE POSSIBILITY OF PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS RESULTING THEREFROM.

In consideration of the City agreeing to my participation in the Activity and permitting my use of their services, property, equipment and other facilities, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby agree as follows:

TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may in the future have against the City and its directors, councilors, officers, employees, instructors, guides, agents, representatives, independent contractors, subcontractors, suppliers, sponsors, successors and assigns (all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "the RELEASEES"), AND TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury, including death, that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of my participation in the Activity, DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER THE OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT, ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES, AND FURTHER INCLUDING THE FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME FROM THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY;

TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES for any and all liability for any property damage, loss or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in the Activity;

This Release Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity;

This Release Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Release Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws and Courts of the Province of Ontario and no other jurisdiction; and

Any litigation involving the parties to this Release Agreement shall be brought solely within the Province of Ontario and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Ontario.

In entering into this Release Agreement I am not relying on any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees with respect to the safety of participating in the Activity, other than what is set forth in this Release Agreement.

I CONFIRM THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT PRIOR TO SIGNING IT. I CONFIRM THAT I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE AGREEMENT, I ASSUME ALL RISKS AND AM RESPONSIBLE FOR MY OWN SAFETY, AND THAT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE RELEASEES.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Family Registration is considered to be a maximum group of 5 people:
 - 2 parents/guardians and 3 children under the age of 18 who are part of the same household.
 - Children 2 and under are free.
- First-come, first-served with t-shirt sizes, sunglasses, and individual colour packets.
- Once you pick up your t-shirt at pre-registration, you can individualize and decorate them.
- Final Blast is Saturday July 18th, at approximately 11:10am.
- Be sure to share your photos with the hashtag *#IGotColourBlasted* and *#colourblastssm*.
- Dress appropriately for the weather.
- Bring a change of clothes or towel to sit on for your ride home.
- Protect your valuables (phone, wallet, keys, etc.), by placing them in a plastic bag.

HOW TO GET CLEAN ASAP

Before Miracle Mile Colour Blast:

- Wear a good sunscreen & lip balm
- Use a leave in conditioner or hair oil
- Wear a hat
- Wear a dark nail polish

After Miracle Mile Colour Blast:

- Dust off as much powder as possible before rinsing with cold water
- Use eye makeup remover to remove colour from skin
- Use a shampoo as a body wash to remove colour from skin
